### **SB 5974: Addressing transportation resources (Move Ahead Washington).**

- Passage of a transportation revenue package is one of the environmental community’s top 4 priorities for the 2022 Legislative Session.
- \$3 billion in transit funding, including \$1.45 for transit support grants and youth fare free and a new Tribal Transit Grant Program.
- \$1.27 billion for active transit, including increases in safe routes to school and a new program for connecting communities to address the past harms of the transportation system on communities.
- \$3 billion in maintenance and preservation of our current system.
- Investments from the Climate Commitment Act funding that reduces carbon emissions.
- This package is the cleanest transportation revenue package in state history.
